The enclosed application must include at least two letters of recommendation, your high school or college transcript and your SAT scores. Other supporting materials are accepted, however, please do not send large attachments or video tapes. Please submit seven collated copies of the following items: your application, letters of recommendation, transcript (photocopies accepted) and supporting materials. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

The NCAS Endowment Fund Committee will consider presentation when reviewing the applications. **Applications must be typed.** Handwritten applications will not be considered. You can send an email to ncas@ncsports.org to request an electronic copy of the application in Word format. If your responses to the questions cannot be expressed in the space given, you may attach additional pages with your complete answers.

Eligibility Requirements

All applicants must meet the following criteria: be a **2010 State Games of North Carolina participant**, currently have a minimum 3.5 GPA, be a rising high school senior or older, and must be presently attending or planning to attend an institution of higher learning. Applicants younger than rising high school seniors are not eligible to apply. Scholarship recipients must use the funds within three years.
